Dress Code Policy

Purpose

Arabella Golf Club is committed to maintaining the traditions and standards of the game while providing a welcoming and enjoyable environment for all members and guests. All Members, guests and visitors are expected to adhere to the dress code outlined below.

Golf Course Dress Code

All golfers are required to present themselves neatly in appropriate golf attire at all times while on the golf course.

Ladies

- Golf shirts, sleeveless golf tops with collars, mock-neck golf tops, and golf dresses are permitted.
- Tailored golf trousers, skorts, skirts, capris, and golf shorts are permitted.
- Golf shoes or suitable sports shoes are permitted.

Gentlemen

- Collared golf shirts or recognised golf mock-neck shirts must be worn.
- Shirts should be neatly tucked in were designed to be worn as such.
- Tailored golf trousers or tailored golf shorts are permitted.
- Golf shoes or suitable sports shoes are permitted.

Attire Not Permitted

- T-shirts, collarless shirts, vests, or tank tops.
- Denim jeans, denim shorts, or denim skirts.
- Caps or visors worn backwards.
- High-heeled shoes.
- Clothing deemed inappropriate for a golf course environment, including garments that are excessively worn, torn, revealing, or display offensive language or imagery.

Arabella Golf Club reserves the right to refuse access to the golf course to any person not complying with the dress code.

Clubhouse Dress Code

The Arabella Golf Club clubhouse is a premium facility that reflects the standards, traditions, and reputation of the Club. Members and guests are therefore requested to dress in a manner that is respectful of the environment and considerate of fellow patrons enjoying the facilities. While the clubhouse promotes a relaxed and welcoming atmosphere, attire should remain neat, clean, and appropriate at all times. The dress code is intended to preserve the character of the club, ensure a comfortable experience for all visitors, and maintain the high standards expected of a leading golf destination.

Driving Range and 10th Hole Putting Green

The driving range and practice facilities allow for a more relaxed dress code while still maintaining the standards of the club.

Permitted Attire

- Relaxed golf-appropriate attire.
- Neat activewear suitable for practice sessions.
- Golf shoes, sneakers, or trainers.

Prohibited Attire

- Swimwear.
- Torn or excessively worn clothing.
- Bare feet.

Members and guests are encouraged to maintain a neat and presentable appearance while using all practice facilities.

General

The Golf Operations Team and Club Management reserve the right to determine the suitability of any attire and may refuse access to club facilities where dress standards are not met.

We thank all members and guests for their cooperation in maintaining the high standards and traditions of Arabella Golf Club.

Golf Course Etiquette

Golfers are expected to uphold and enhance the condition of the course by replacing divots, repairing ball marks, raking bunkers, and properly disposing of any litter or debris left on the Course. The goal for all Golfers is to leave the Course in better condition than they found it.

Golf Cart Rules

The use of golf carts is strictly limited to individuals who are 18 years of age or older and hold a valid driver's licence. No more than two persons may occupy a golf cart at any time.

To protect the condition and presentation of the golf course, golfers are required to operate carts responsibly and in accordance with all course signage. Golf carts must remain on designated cart paths wherever provided and should maintain a reasonable distance from tees and greens. During periods of wet weather, course maintenance, or when course conditions require additional protection, a cart path only policy may be implemented. In such instances, golfers are expected to always keep carts on the designated paths.
