APÉRITIF

An apéritif is an alcoholic beverage usually served before a meal to stimulate the appetite, and is therefore usually dry rather than sweet. Apéritif is a French word derived from the Latin verb aperire, which means "to open".

Are both sweet fortified wines. Port originating from Portugal and sherry from southern Spain. As with many wines, port and sherry range from connoisseur quality to inexpensive mass produced versions. Both can be drunk either before or after a meal.

GIN & CRAFT GIN

Gin has a fascinating history that goes right back to when the first spirits were distilled in Europe. Juniper berries were first distilled with cereal grains in Holland during the fifteenth century. Today's sprawling assortment of gin styles reflects the many 'botanicals' now used to produce it. Along with juniper, the predominant 'London dry' style often contains top notes of coriander, cassia bark, citrus peel, and angelica root.

COGNAC & BRANDY

Cognac is now a byword for sophistication and excellence in spirit making. It is made in and around the town of Cognac in Western France. With a few exceptions, all other spirits made from distilled wine are labelled simply as brandy. Cognac has a distinctive, floral grapey perfume. While Brandy is liquor distilled from wine or other fermented fruit juice. The name brandy comes from the Dutch "brandewijn" (burnt wine) referring to the technique of heating the wine during fermentation.

BLENDED WHISKY

This is an alcoholic distillate made from a fermented mash of grains such as barley, rye or corn. The name come from the Celtic "Uisgebaugh", which means water of life. Many factors influence a whisky's quality and flavour including the type of grain and yeast used, the method of distillation, how it is aged and the water source.

TEQUILA

A colourless or pale straw-coloured liquor made by fermenting and distilling the sweet sap of the Agave plant. It is made in and around the small town of Tequila, in Mexico's Jalisco province. In order to be classified as tequila, distilled spirits must be produced from the blue agave plants grown in a precisely delineated area in the five Mexican states of Guanajuato, Jalisco, Michoacan, Mayarit and Tamaulipas. Tequilas labelled 100% Blue Agave are considered the best.
