Auction Wine

Thorne & Daughters Semillon / Sauvignon Blanc 2024 4400

This wine is John's first CWG Auction wine. The wine marries John's fascination with classic, Old-World wines and the wildness of our dryland Paardeberg Sémillon and Skurfberg Sauvignon Blanc vineyards in the Western Cape. The 2024 vintage gave us the ripeness and concentration we could use as a backbone for this elegant and intricate wine. Meticulous and minimalist winemaking allowed for complexity and age-worthiness over stark, primary fruit. Tasting Notes: Notes of ripe yellow fruit, struck match, oak spice and saline elements on the nose. The wine is dense, voluminous and layered on the palate without carrying unnecessary weight

Jordan Wine Estate CWG Auction Reserve Chardonnay 2024 4800

The distinct ravine which embodies Stellenbosch Kloof harnesses all the qualities of a well-orientated compass. Varying elevations and aspects allows us to grow a selection of classic varieties to specific sites that optimise this expression through their location. The cooler south- and east-facing aspects, unique in Stellenbosch, hosts the more sensitive and aromatic white-skinned grape varieties. Stellenbosch Kloof enjoys a cooler Mediterranean climate with maritime influences from False Bay, 14km to the south, and a refreshing breeze channelled from the West Coast's Benguela current 24km to the north-west. These two breezes

culminate at the top end of the ravine and bring in early morning mists, especially from False Bay. Consequently, temperatures in our meso-climate can be measured at least 3° Celsius cooler than inland Stellenbosch during ripening periods. This adds a unique characteristic to Jordan wines.

TASTING NOTES

An iconic Chardonnay with intense, mineral, lemon-lime flavours and hints of butterscotch and vanilla. The full, rich mouthfeel and balanced oak integrates superbly with the tropical fruit finish.

Frans K. Smit Lamed Cabernet Sauvignon / Cabernet 2021 3700

The grapes are cultivated on the Helderberg, just 8 km from the sea. All varieties are grown within a 400-m radius. The deep, rich red soils, combined with an average elevation of 250 m above sea level and the daily cooling sea breezes, create an ideal terroir for Bordeaux-style grapes.

WINEMAKING

The grapes were hand-harvested, destemmed, and the berries hand-sorted before fermentation in stainless-steel tanks. After 28 months of barrel maturation and rigorous barrel selection, the wine underwent gentle light filtration and bottling.

NOSE & PALATE

Rich and complex, with a seamless, velvety texture and layered aromas of red currant and cacao. Its deep concentration, a signature of the high Petit Verdot content, suggests excellent maturation potential.

Red Wine.

Ernie Els Wines Cabernet Sauvignon / Shiraz 2022 3700

The 2022 vintage will definitely be remembered as the year where we had good fruit set. After pruning, budburst came about two weeks later than expected. This resulted in flowering occurring in a period with cooler temperatures. More berries per vine means a good balance between reproductive and vegetative growth, and, because we restrict pruning to allow for a certain tonnage per hectare, we don't overburden the leaves. Mild conditions allowed the vines to catch up nicely with warm days after veraison. The heat before harvest is very important for the development of red cultivars and especially for the premium quality of our Cabernet Sauvignon.

Delaire Graff Estate Cabernet Sauvignon - Cabernet Franc 4400

Cape Winemakers Guild Auction: Banghoek Cabernet Sauvignon - Cabernet Franc 2022

72% Cabernet Sauvignon, 28% Cabernet Franc Wine of Origin Banghoek - Stellenbosch

Winemaker: Morné Very

Tasting Notes:

Bright, forward red fruit aromas are complemented by subtle oak spice and violet notes. The palate reveals firm yet delicate tannins, underscoring a refined and balanced finish.

Rock of Eye CWG Auction Cabernet Sauvignon CWG 5500

The grapes were fermented in open-top fermenters, with manual punch-downs performed three times per day to optimize extraction. The wine was then matured for 18 months in French oak barrels, with 20% new oak to preserve the fruit while allowing the fruit and oak tannins to be seamlessly integrated. The wine was bottled on the 20th of November 2023.

TASTING NOTES: The colour is mid-crimson with a cerise edge, offering a vibrant hue.

On the nose, forward and attractive aromas of blackcurrant and bilberry are complemented by top notes of violets, adding a floral lift. Savory and spicy elements, including hints of cedar, fynbos, and nutmeg, bring depth, adding detail and intrigue to the aroma. On the palate, red and black berries, along with mulberry and cherry fruits, come together, enhanced by vibrant acidity and sleek, silky tannins. This perfumed and savoury character adds complexity, softening the tannins and making them feel less youthful and grippy. As the maiden vintage, this wine displays tight, classic dry tannins in its youth showcasing both the strength and subtle sophistication of Cabernet from Stellenbosch. It is expected to evolve beautifully over the next 8-15 years, gaining complexity and subtlety with age.

Beaumont Family Wines Arturo's Pinotage 4500

This wine originates from a remarkable vineyard planted in 1974 on an east-facing slope of clay-shale soils. With tiny yields and concentrated fruit, it captures the fresh, nuanced side of Pinotage in a medium-bodied style. Pinotage has been at the heart of Beaumont Family Wines since their first vintage in 1994. Named in tribute to Arthur Pillman – whose passion and belief in winemaking served as inspiration – this wine is a reflection of legacy and place.

Tasting Notes: Vibrant in colour with inviting aromas of red berries, ripe cherry and plum, accented by a touch of spice for added complexity. The palate shows a pure, cool entry with red fruit vibrancy, fine dry tannins, and a long, elegant finish.

Paradigm Strydom Family Wines Cabernet Sauvignon / Cabernet Franc/Petit Verdot 4500

56% Cabernet Sauvignon, 34% Cabernet Franc, 10% Petit Verdot

This is the first time since 2016 that this blend has been made for the CWG

Auction. It was created specifically for the auction and does not form part of our usual portfolio. One 300-litre barrel was made from small volumes from individually selected barrels after 12 months in oak. The blend was then matured for another 6 months before bottling. The total time in barrel was 18 months, with 50% new oak.

The Cabernet Sauvignon gives good structure and length. The Cabernet Franc adds the freshness, red fruit and herb flavours. The Petit Verdot brings the darker berry notes and depth as a final touch.

Warwick Auction Cabernet Sauvignon / Cabernet Franc 5400

Tasting note:

A dark and brooding nose reveals layers of cassis, dark berries, lavender and spice. The palate is broad and structured, with tightly knit tannins framing concentrated dark berry flavours.

The finish is long, textured and compelling.

Ready for drinking from 2030 - 2035.

Winemaking procedure :Crafted from the two best-performing vineyards on Warwick Estate over the past decade .The Cabernet Franc (clone 623B) was planted in 2008, and the Cabernet Sauvignon (clone 46A) in 2012. These vineyards consistently produce fruit of exceptional character and depth

Newton Johnson Family Vineyard Windansea Pinot Noir 4850

This cuvée of Windansea is a bare-bones glimpse of the stony, eastern side expression of the vineyard. This powerhouse vineyard is the framework or armature on which our Family Vineyards Pinot Noir is built. The bunches were selectively picked for this small cuvée, in the stoniest and most clay rich of our Granitic soil. It is made without sulphur in the winemaking, allowing diverse and dynamic elements from the grape itself to flourish unrestrained.

Windansea is the power dimension to Pinot Noir on our farm, a wine with purity and symmetry that will last at least 15 years in bottle.

TASTING NOTES

A lavish expression, saturated with blackberry, liquorice and rich red currants. Lingering impressions of soft spice and freshly turned earth. Bountiful and seamless tannin texture into a chalky finish.

Neil Ellis Wines Amper Bo Tempranillo 2021 3200

Wine is both an art and science. For the winemaker it is a meeting of the heart and mind. It is trying to find a medium where technology and tradition can co-exist. The name Amper Bo is a tribute to farm where the vines are grown. The style was inspired by the George Spies Cabs of the Cabernet Sauvignon of the sixties. This is an un-oaked Tempranillo. A true reflection of terroir. Winemaking Notes: A single vineyard, small batch, whole berry fermentation was initiated in a stainless-steel tank. The grapes underwent a series of punch-downs and pump-overs until dry. No barrels were used maturing this wine. A pure expression of Tempranillo from the decomposed granite soils of the Stellenbosch Bottelary Hills.

Tasting Notes: A subtle nose reflecting red cherries, violets, herbs and tobacco leading into a leathery finish. The palate is dense and complex, packed with dark berries and plum which unfolds with great length, freshness and balance. Followed by fine chalky tannins.

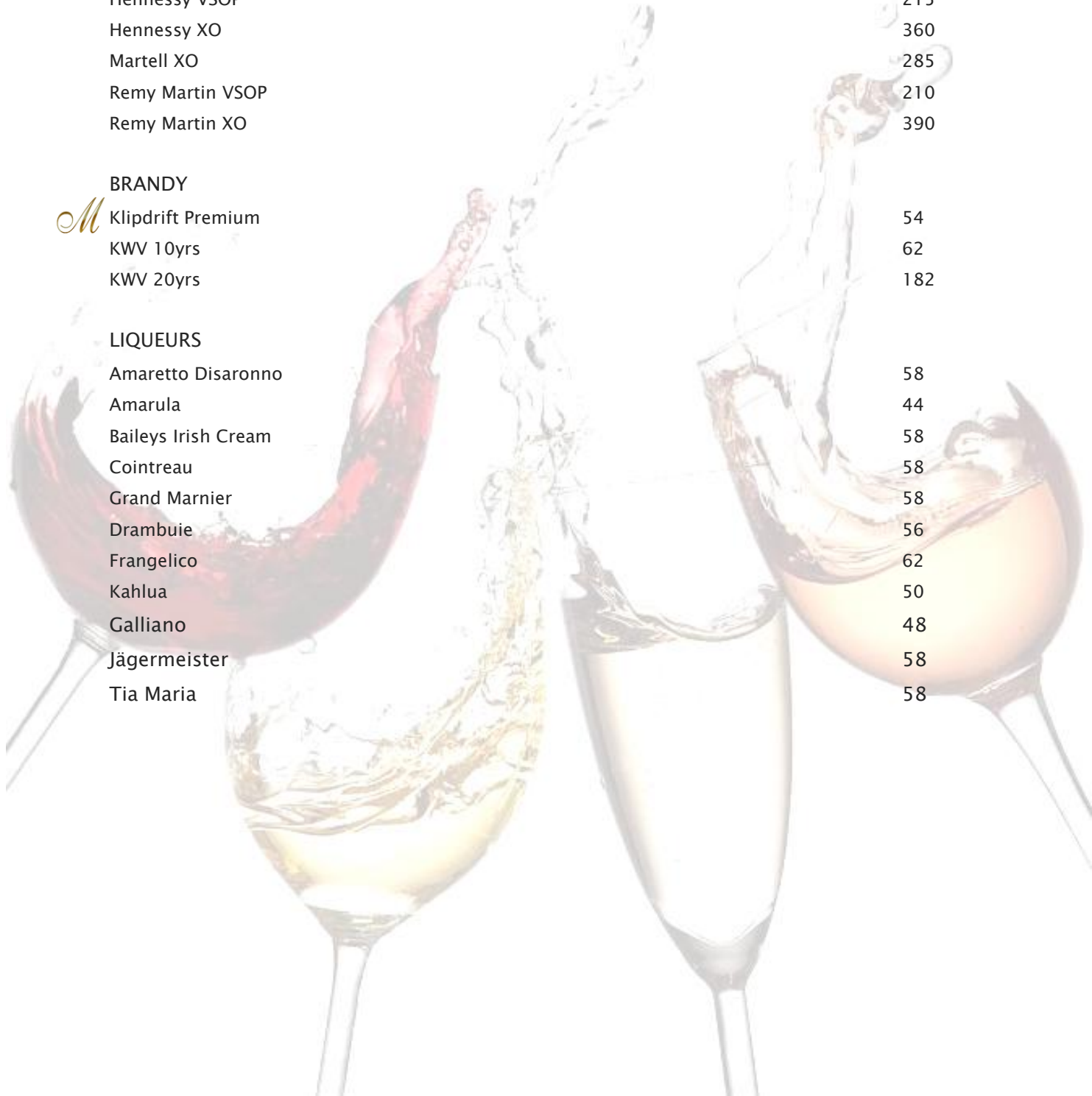


